

Changes Planned for Franklin Boulevard in Glenwood

Progress continues towards constructing the multi-way boulevard envisioned in the plans to revitalize Glenwood. The project will result in additional sidewalk, bicycle lanes, lighting, and landscaped stormwater treatment. Federal authorities approved the <u>Concept Design</u>, allowing engineering investigations needed for detailed design to get underway. You may see the project's existing conditions being surveyed and technicians collecting ground samples now. You can also expect to see utility work in 2015 to relocate and/or upgrade their facilities.


Springfield's project manager and Principal Engineer, Kristi Krueger, is working with an engineering and design team led by CH2M Hill. The project timeline shows 2015 engineering and design work, and utilities upgrades to prepare for an estimated 2016 start of construction.
